## THE SECRET POWER OF JOY – PSALM 16:11

JOY AND HAPPINESS may be closely related but they are not the same thing. Joy is a spiritual gift from God. Happiness is a fleeting human emotion. The Bible uses the word happy and happiness about 40 times. However, joy and rejoice is used 300 times or more (depending on the translation). The main difference between happiness and joy is that happiness is a temporary emotion triggered by a positive circumstance. Joy is not a feeling. Joy is a spiritual gift from God that can endure difficult circumstances. Happiness will disappear in the face of adversity. Joy is more powerful, even more powerful than most people realize. Let me give you five important facts about JOY:

#### 1. JOY IS THE SOURCE OF SPIRITUAL STRENGTH.

Sing for joy to the God of our strength; Psalm 81:1

Do not grieve, for the joy of the Lord is your strength. Nehemiah 8:10b

#### 2. JOY IS AN ANTI-DEPRESSANT.

And now my head will be lifted up above my enemies around me, and I will offer in His tent sacrifices with shouts of joy; I will sing, yes, I will sing praises to the LORD. Psalm 27:6

## 3. JOY IS A DEFENSE AGAINST ENEMIES.

But let all those rejoice who put their trust in You; Let them ever shout for joy, because You defend them; Let those also who love Your name be joyful in You. Psalm 5:11 (See Jehoshaphat - 2 Chronicles 20:21)

4. JOY IS HELP IN TIMES OF NEED AND TROUBLE.						
I will be glad and rejoice in Your mercy, for You have considered my trouble;						
You have known my soul in adversities. Psalm 31:7						
5. JOY AMPLIFIES GOD'S WORD.						
I rejoice at Your word as one who finds great treasure. Psalm 119:162
